


## Important information from Växjöbostäder concerning Systematic Fire-Prevention Work

Corridors, stairwells, joint balconies, access balconies and basements are common areas that must never be used for the storage of any items. It can pose a serious safety risk if evacuation would be necessary in the event of fire and for the ingress or egress of ambulance services.

According to the Law on the Prevention of Accidents, the property owner and the tenant have a joint obligation and responsibility to prevent accidents. Therefore, you must not block public areas and exit routes.

When you see this symbol  on items stored in common areas, you must remove the items at once. Henceforth, we will charge a fee for the removal of such items.

The Fire Protection Authority regularly carries out inspections of our properties and does not look favourably upon items stored in common areas. Their remarks can lead to the imposition of a penalty (fine), resulting in considerable and unnecessary costs for Växjöbostäder and ultimately also for you as a tenant.

We recommend that combustible liquids, such as fire-lighting fluid or methylated spirits are stored on balconies.
